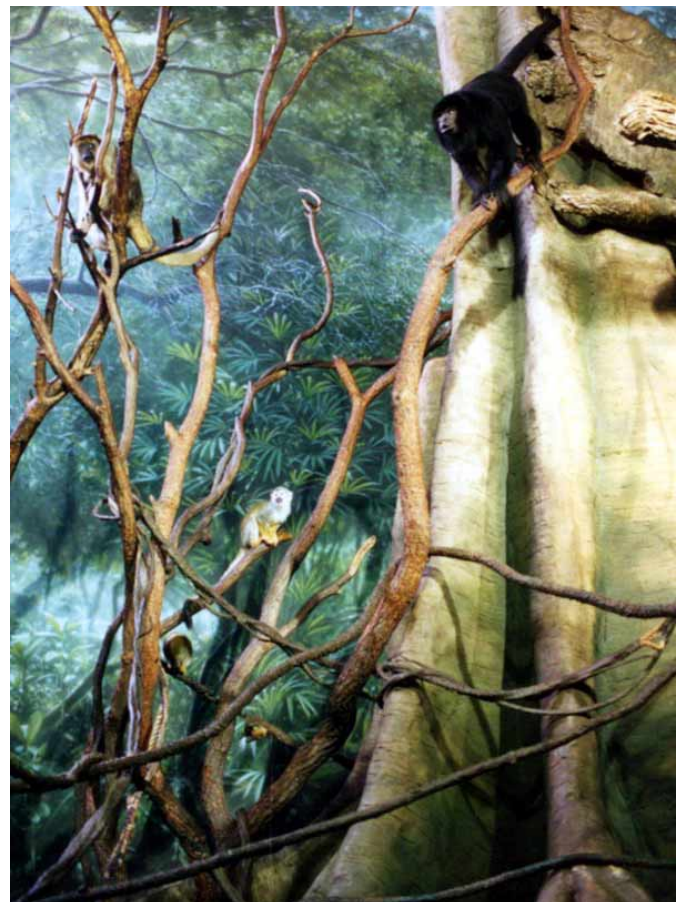


We presently produce 3 types of vines (resin, vinyl, and urethane), as well as three different styles for the vinyl vines (smooth, rough, and hairy). The resin vines are the most indestructible, good for orangutans, mandrills, and other destructive species. The urethane vines are good for gibbons, siamangs, etc. They also can be used as insulators for hot wire. The vinyl vines are excellent for the smaller species and are the better looking of all of the vines.

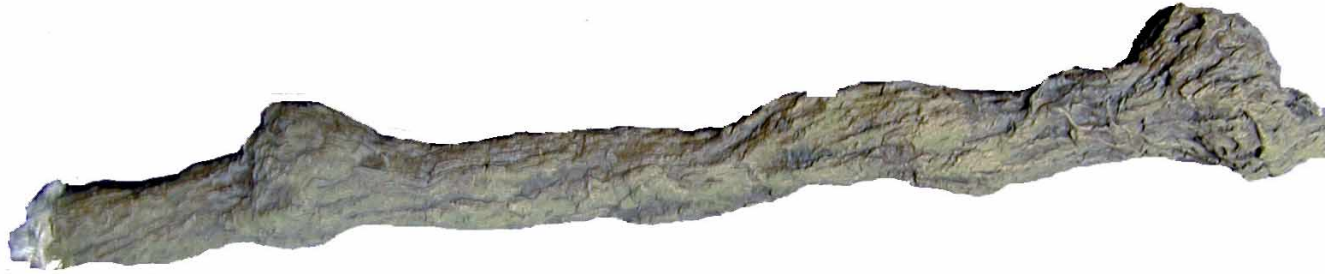
Here is a picture of the rope before the texture. Note the different sizes and the metal cable going through the rope.

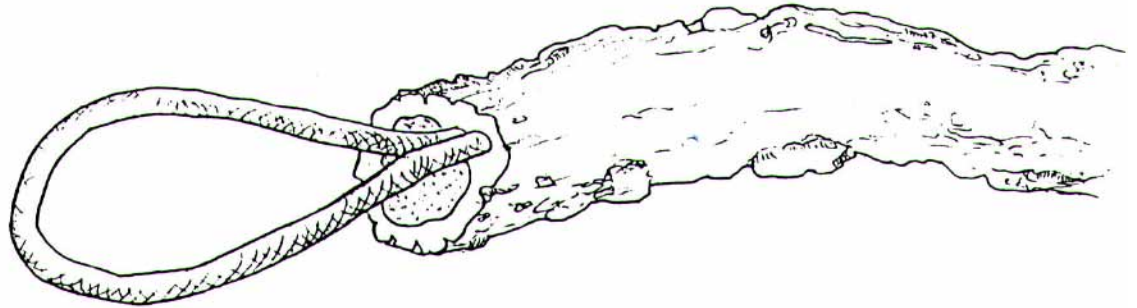

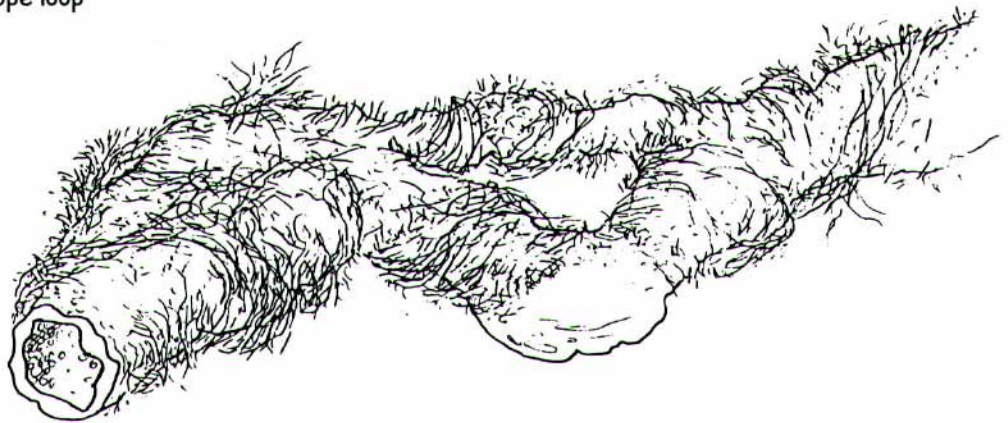

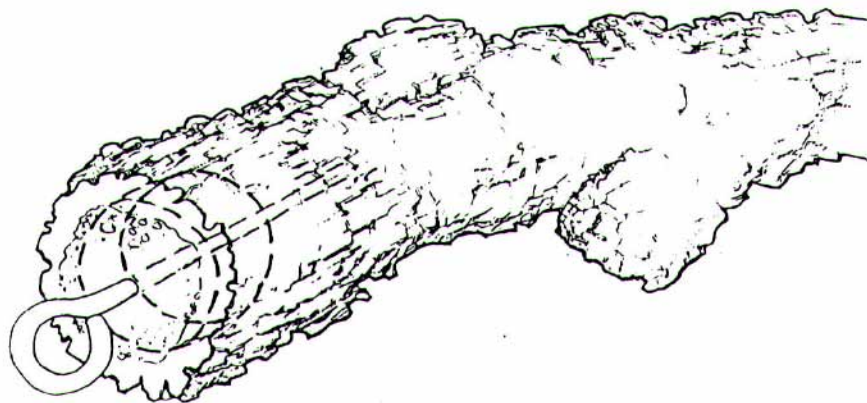

Scale 1"= 3/4"



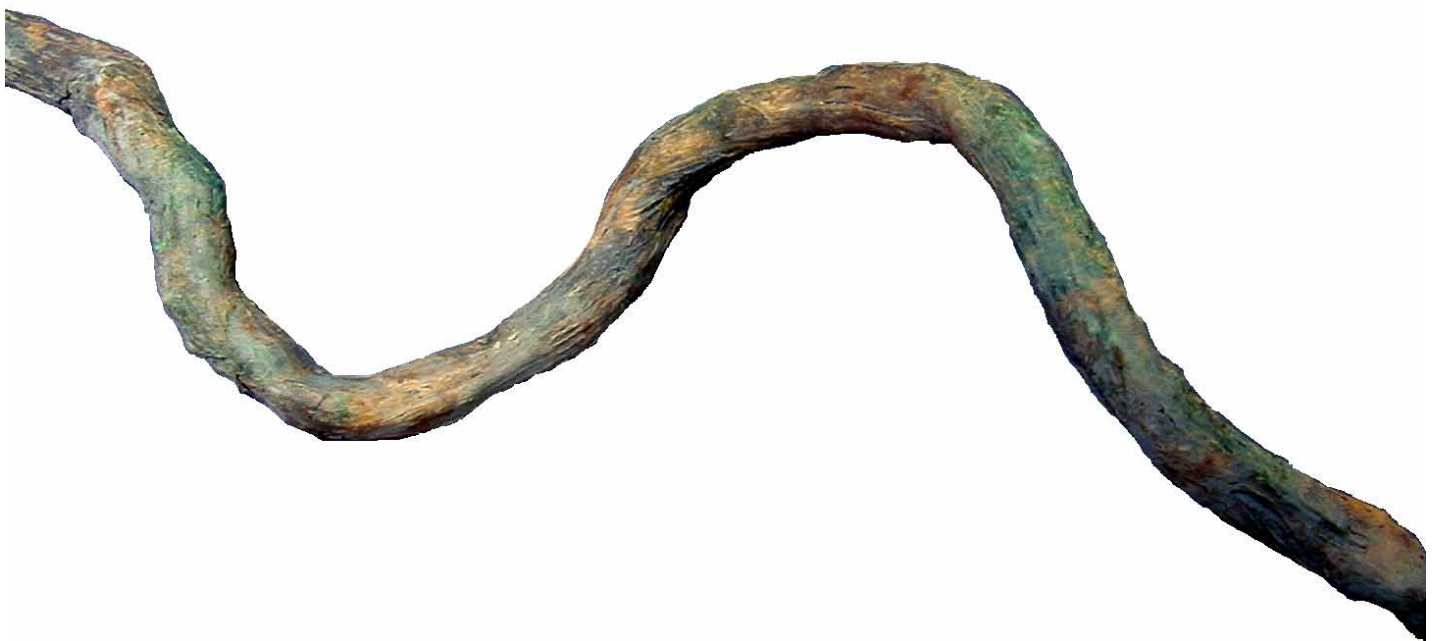
HAIRY TEXTURE

1) 'QUICK LINK' = 



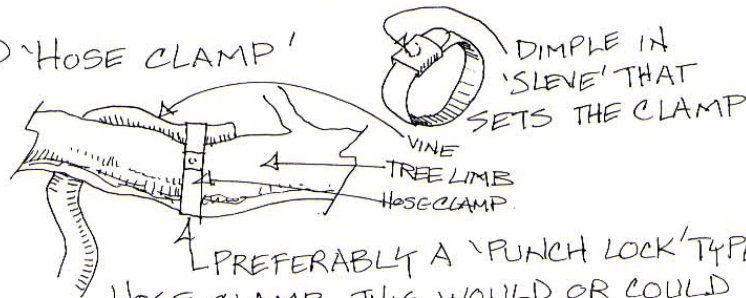
10 GAUGE WIRE IN END OF VINE USED TO TIE ON QUICK LINK

2) 'EYE SCREW' 



10 GAUGE WIRE + THREADED END OF EYE SCREW IN END OF VINE

3) 'HOSE CLAMP'



PREFERABLY A 'PUNCH LOCK' TYPE HOSE CLAMP. THIS WOULD OR COULD BE COATED WITH EPOXY OR 'PAINTED OUT'.
