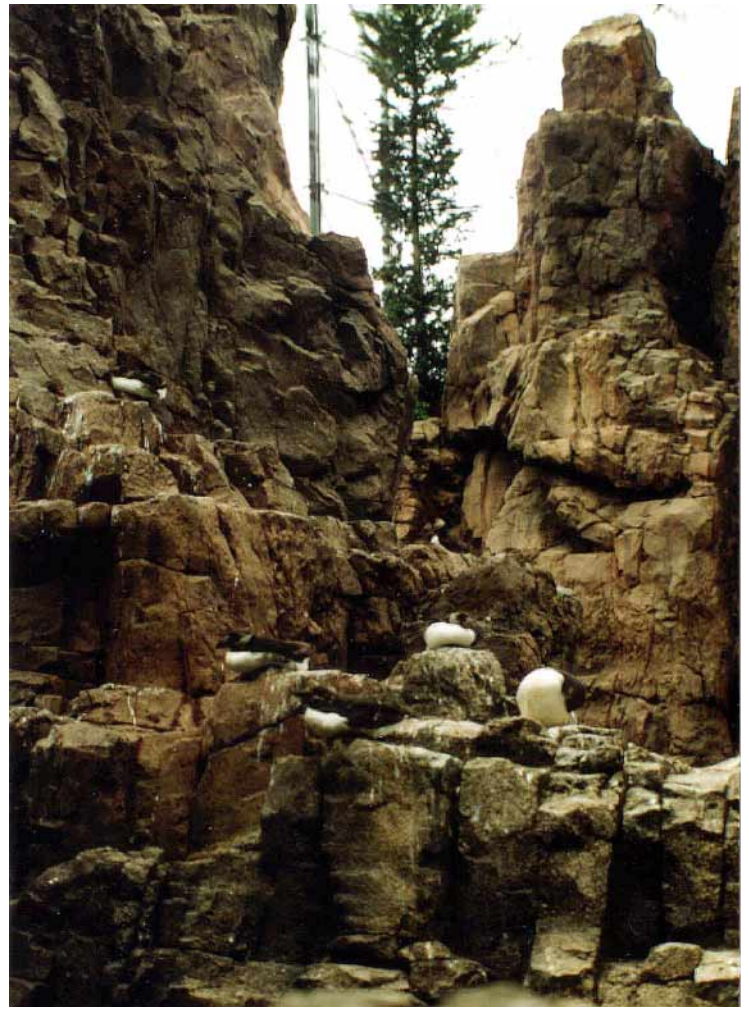

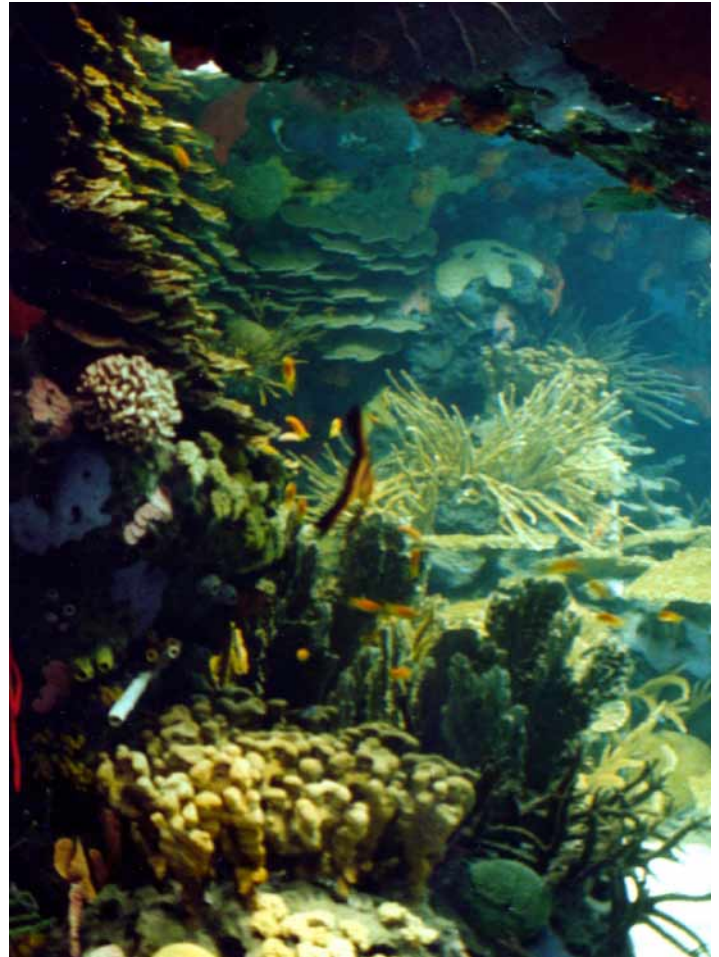
David Manwarren started the company in 1979, after working for over 10 years as the artistic supervisor for a large habitat company. In 1983, after a few years of doing commercial and residential projects, the company started working with the Los Angeles Zoo.



Since that time the company has built over 270 individual Zoological exhibits (mammals, primates, great apes, reptiles, birds, etc.), over 175 aquarium exhibits (shark tanks, coral reefs, fresh water tanks, pinnipeds, cetaceans, temperate tanks, etc.), and over 200 individual fiberglass inserts for aquariums. Over 60% of these projects were design and builds. Combined with all of the master plans, designs, education plans, museum projects, feasibility studies, design consultations with other designers, the company has been involved in over 800 Zoo, Aquarium, and Museum projects world wide. The company has been very honored to win several AZA Exhibit Awards, an CAZPA Exhibit Award, Educational Awards, Design Awards, as well as many Landscaping Awards. Recently in a book called Aquaria (written descriptions of most of the aquariums in the world), David was said to be the most important professional in Aquarium Exhibits.

Our company is in a 44,000 square foot building on 6 acres in Rancho Cucamonga, California.
